

Butcher, Baker and Chocolate Maker

Friday 20th July - Monday 23rd July 2012

Friday Departing Bradford at 10.00, we travel to **Clumber Park** which was the part of the estates of the Dukes of Newcastle. The woods, park and lake are home to an amazing array of wildlife. From here we travel to our hotel, arriving early afternoon enabling you to spend time exploring the historic city of **Lincoln**.

Saturday We travel to **Kirton-in-Lindsey** to visit the **Mount Pleasant Windmill**, which has been restored to full working order and is now the home to the **True Loaf Bakery**. The mill is used to grind organic grain for the flour used to produce delicious breads and cakes cooked in the traditional wood fired oven. Also included is a tour of the mill. From here we travel to North Willingham to visit **Willingham Fayre Ice Cream** for a demonstration and a chance to try the wares.

Sunday Today we start with a trip to **Folkingham** to visit **Hansen's Chocolate House**, where there will be a talk and a chance to watch Jan Hansen and his team make the chocolate, as well as to visit the shop to purchase the wares. From here we travel to **Doddington Hall**, a family home which has never been sold since it was built in 1595. The wall gardens have barely changed since then and the interior was redecorated in Georgian times in a light and elegant manner.

Monday After spending the morning in **Lincoln** we travel for a lunchtime visit to the **Pink Pig Farm** where in addition to a cafe offering local produce, there is a farm shop stocking their own pork, eggs, homecured bacon and ham, free range chickens plus a wide range of seasonal organic vegetables. In the afternoon we continue to **Epworth** to visit the **Old Rectory**, the childhood home of John and Charles Wesley, the founders of the Methodist church. The guided tour will enable you to see how people lived in the early 1700's and bringing the history of the 18th century to life. From here we travel back to Bradford arriving early evening.
