

Saturday We join our boat at Caversham Pier in Reading for our **90 minute cruise on the River Thames** following the river upstream taking in the wildlife and open countryside. The cruise will turn at Mapledurham Lock taking in a panoramic view of the weir before travelling back to Reading. Monday Departing Bradford at 09.30 we stop at **Settle** for a midmorning break before we travel to Heysham to catch our Isle of Man Steam Packet ferry to the island.

Tuesday We join the **Isle of Man Steam Railway** for a scenic journey to **Port Erin**, where we join the coach which will take us to Peel, an attractive town in the shadow of the ruins of a once magnificent castle, where seals can often be seen in the harbour. From here we travel across the island, stopping for a photo opportunity at **Tynwald Hill**, the site of the ancient Parliament of the island.

Wednesday We will call at **Laxey**, where you will have a chance to view the 'Lady Isabella, the world's largest working watermill and perhaps the best known image of the island (no admissions included). We then join the **Snaefell Mountain Railway** which dates from Victorian Times and takes us from Laxey to the peak of the islands only mountain. We return to **Douglas** to give you time to explore the islands capital.

Thursday We plan to travel by coach, to **Ramsey**, the delightful resort town and one of the most popular destinations on the island. The return journey will be riding on the Victorian and Edwardian rolling stock of the **Manx Electric Railway** back to **Douglas**, where time will be your own.

Friday We journey home ,on the Isle of Man Steam Packet to Heysham, arriving home mid afternoon.

Tuesday Today we travel to **Shrewsbury**, one of England's finest medieval market towns where **we enjoy a walking tour with a local guide**. You will then have free time to explore the quaint narrow streets and hidden alleyways. In the afternoon we take a relaxing **45 minute cruise on the picturesque River Severn** loop to see the town from the water.

Wednesday This morning we take a leisurely drive over the Shropshire Hills via Bishop's Castle and Knighton to the thriving market town of **Ludlow**, described by the poet John Betjeman as 'probably the loveliest town in England'. We then travel to **Kidderminster for a ride behind a steam locomotive on the Severn Valley Railway**. The 16 mile run to **Bridgnorth** follows the River Severn through glorious and unspoilt countryside. On arrival there is free time to explore, possibly taking in the steepest inland funicular cliff railway between the upper and lower town.

Thursday We start the day with a visit to the **Jackfield Tile Museum** which presents the history of the British decorative tile industry between 1840 and 1960. We then travel to **Ironbridge Gorge World Heritage Site**, where you can see the iconic bridge which spans the River Severn, it was the world's first iron bridge and has attracted tourists since its opening in 1779. From here we travel home arriving early evening.

Liverpool & Chester - Christmas is a-coming



Sunday Departing Bradford at 09.30 we travel to **Liverpool**, a vibrant city with its two cathedrals, varied shopping and museums. In addition the famous Christmas Market should be in full swing with chalets throughout the Liverpool 1 shopping plaza.

Unusually, below stairs there are servants' portraits, both oil paintings and photographs, together with a unique selection of poems dedicated to each servant. Outside the restored 18th century walled garden with tranquil water features and orchards are well worth a visit. We arrived home mid evening.

Edinburgh Christmas Market and Dumfries House



Sunday Departing Bradford at 08.30 we travel, with a stop en route, to **Berwick-upon –Tweed**, the historic town that over the centuries has been much contested between England and Scotland and has frequently changed hands. It is famous for the Elizabethan fortifications that surround the town which provide a beautiful walk with views across the River Tweed to the North Sea, and the historic bridges.

Monday We travel into **Edinburgh**, the historic capital of Scotland with its magnificent buildings and shopping. Against the backdrop of the famous castle is the **Christmas Market** situated in East Princes Street Gardens. Here, you will find traditional chalets serving artisan festive foods, decorations, gifts and little treats. There are street food vendors serving everything from Bavarian produce to Scottish delicacies and winter tipples, craft beers and hot chocolate. The market is just across the road from Princes Street, famous for its variety of shopping.

Tuesday We visit **Dumfries House**, whose restoration was a project close to the heart of King Charles III and is a 2,000 acre estate and 18th century Palladian country house. The house, one of few such houses with much of its original 18th century furniture still present including specially commissioned Chippendale pieces. We will take the **Guided Grand Tour** of the house which **includes rooms not usually visited**. The house will be decked out with thousands of lights and baubles, using sustainable materials like glass and paper inspired by the Kings eco-conscious vision. From here, we travel home with a stop en-route arriving mid evening.

Sunday We journey into **Bristol**, with our route taking in Isambard Kingdom Brunel's magnificent **Clifton Suspension Bridge** on our way to another of his masterpieces **SS Great Britain**. Here you will visit one of the most important historic ships in the world, which when launched in 1843 was called "the greatest experiment in history".

On board you can discover the many innovations of the vessel, its history which led to it being abandoned in the Falkland Islands to its return home and restoration. The afternoon will be spent in **Bristol** where you can enjoy the **Christmas Market** with the other attractions which include the vibrant revitalised harbour side.

Monday We start the journey home with a visit to the delightful Cotswold market town of **Stow-on -the -Wold**, which is famous for its antique shops, cafes, pubs and inns. From here we travel home, with a stop en route, arriving early evening.

Tuesday Departing Bradford at 09.00 we travel, with a stop en route, to the historic city of **Carlisle** for our lunch time break.
