October

Saturday 4th October.

North Yorks Moors to Whitby.

£59.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 19.00.

We take a ride by steam train on the North York Moors Railway from Pickering enjoying spectacular scenery to Whitby. Once in Whitby you will have a chance to enjoy the attractions of this delightful resort. The return journey, by coach, takes in the majestic moorland views. (NB steam engine subject to availability).

Wednesday 8th October.

Bury Market including Fish & Chips.

£40.45pp. Depart code A. Departs 09.30 - Return 18.00.

From the exotic to the everyday Bury Market has it all, with over 200 stalls you are sure to find whatever you want at bargain prices. From here we travel to the award winning Olympus Fish and Chip restaurant in Bolton for a traditional meal of cod, chips, peas, bread and butter with tea or coffee.

Wednesday 15th October.

Autumn Colours - Richmond & Aysgarth Falls.

£27.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return 17.30.

We visit the market town of Richmond, with its cobbled streets overshadowed by the ruins of the imposing castle. Here there is a host of individual shops, eateries and cultural and heritage attractions. From here we take a scenic drive to Aysgarth Falls where you will have a chance to visit the falls, and nearby shops. Returning via the dramatic Kidstones Pass.

Saturday 18th October.

Autumn Colours - Dalby Forest & Scarborough.

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

We visit the Dalby Forest Visitor Centre, nestled in the heart of the Low Dalby valley. You can explore the immediate area, enjoy the shops and café. From here we travel to the ever popular resort of Scarborough with its numerous attractions.

Thursday 23rd October.

Pendle Mill, Lytham St Anne's & Blackpool Lights

We visit Pendle Village Mill Shopping Centre, where there are departments offering clothing, shoes household and a garden centre. Onwards to Lytham St Anne's to enjoy the elegant shops and promenade. We will then enjoy a drive through the world famous lights of Blackpool from the comfort of our coach.

Saturday 25th October.

Hull & The Deep.

£44.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

We travel to Hull where you will have time to explore this rejuvenated city as well as visiting the award winning 'The Deep'. The aquarium has numerous highlights, from the underwater tunnel with sharks above you to the beauty of the jellyfish. Also, amongst others, you can see turtles, penguins and stingrays. Among the attractions of Hull itself is the bustling marina whilst Hull Minster is worth a visit

Wednesday 12th November.

Boundary Mill OR Oswaldtwistle Mill.

£24.45pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.30 - Return 17.00.

Boundary Mills is one of the UK's largest mill retailers with clothing, footwear, household and gifts retailed in modern surroundings. OR visit Oswaldtwistle Mills which has many retailers situated under a single roof including Bonmarche, Pavers Shoes and Edinburgh Woollen Mill. Both have dining options.

Wednesday 19th November.

York St Nicholas Fair.

£27.45pp. Depart code B.

Departs 09.30 - Return 17.30.

The fair, with alpine chalets, brings festive cheer to the heart of the city with local crafts, artisan products and delicious seasonal treats, and there is time to also visit York's other attractions.



Thursday 27th November.

Chatsworth Dressed for Christmas.

£67.95pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.30 - Return 18.30.

Chatsworth House will be transformed for the Christmas season, with sumptuous decorations on the lower floor. Outside the Christmas Market will be in full swing with chalets offering food, drink, gifts and a variety of festive treats, whilst the grounds provide tranquil surroundings. There is often live entertainment for you to enjoy.



Saturday 29th November.

Beamish at Christmas.

£52.95pp. Depart code B.

Departs 08.30 - Return for 18.30.

Beamish Open Air Museum highlights life at various times from 1825 to the 1950's through reconstructed houses, shops and commercial buildings. You can hop on the trams to tour the site and sample the Edwardian Bakery and Fish and Chip shop. At this time of year the site will be decked out for Christmas.



December

Wednesday 3rd December.

Tatton at Christmas.

£41.95pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

Christmas at Tatton Park in Cheshire is a magical time of year. Enjoy a walk through the beautifully decorated State rooms with immersive displays, enchanting surprises, music and entertainment. Outside you can enjoy the delightful Italian Garden, shop and restaurant.



Sunday 7th December.

Beverley Festival of Christmas.

£29.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Returns for 17.00.

Beverley is host to a vibrant Christmas Market with a range of attractions including street entertainment to suit all ages. Within the Minster there is a display of decorated Christmas trees with prizes for the best presented.

Saturday 13th December.

Chester Christmas Market.

£33.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

We travel to the magnificent city of Chester to experience the build up to Christmas with lights, trees, decorations and entertainment aplenty close to the magnificent cathedral, together with a variety of shopping.

Wednesday 17th December.

Castle Howard at Christmas.

£52.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 18.00.

This year the House is transformed into the magical World of Oz, through installations, soundscapes and projections. The house will be aglow with the decorations and log fires.



Jan/Feb/March

Saturday 17th January.

Scenic Drive - North to Wensleydale.

£22.50pp. Depart code A.

Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start the New Year with a leisurely drive through the beautiful winter dales scenery to Hawes via Ingleton, taking in the iconic Ribbleshead Viaduct to visit the Wensleydale Creamery with its café, gift and cheese shop.



Saturday 31st January. Scenic Drive - East to Hambleton Hills.

£22.50pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start the day out with a visit to Deans Garden Centre near York, where you can enjoy all things garden related together with gift ideas. We then visit the historic town of Helmsley with its beautiful buildings and variety of shops around the market square. Our return journey will be via Sutton Bani with its magnificent views.

Saturday 14th February.

Scenic Drive - South to the Peak District.

£22.50pp. Depart code B.

Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start our scenic drive via Holmfirth, the Woodhead Pass, Torside Reservoir, through Glossop, with a leisurely break at Brookside Garden Centre near Poynton, well known for its miniature railway that circles the garden centre.



Saturday 7th March. Scenic Drive - West to Lancashire.

£22.50pp. Depart code A. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

Our drive today tracks the course of the River Ribble from Glusburn to Samlesbury before heading north to our destination, Barton Grange Garden Centre, where they have everything to bring your garden and home to life.

Saturday 28th March.

Engine Driver's Fish & Chip's.

£54.95pp. Depart code B.

Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start with a trip over the Pennines to Heywood for a ride on the East Lancashire preserved railway, where we take in views of the valley as we travel by steam train to Rawtenstall (subject to locomotive availability). We then travel for a late lunch of Fish & Chips at the Olympus Fish Restaurant in Bolton.



April

Wednesday 1st April.

Lakes & Daffodils - Penrith & Ullswater Cruise.

£55.75pp. Depart code A.

Depart 08.00 - Return for 19.30.

We visit Settle for a break, before we continue to Penrith, the delightful market town famous for its independent shops and cafes. We then travel to Pooley Bridge, where we will enjoy a scenic cruise on Ullswater to Glenridding taking in the views of the lake and daffodils.



Saturday 4th April.

Cheshire Choice.

£34.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

A choice today of visiting either the historic city of Chester with its magnificent cathedral, Roman Walls and delightful shops **OR** the Cheshire Oaks Designer Outlet shopping with over 100 designer brands.

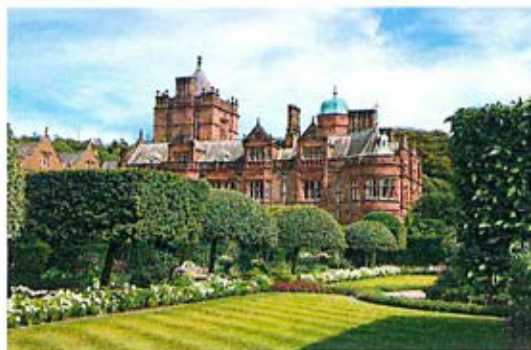
Saturday 11th April.

Kirkby Lonsdale & Holker Hall.

£47.95pp. Depart code A.

Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.00.

We have a mid-morning break in Kirkby Lonsdale, with its attractive shops and cafes, as well as a scenic walk on the banks of the River Lune. Following a fire in 1871 Holker Hall was rebuilt in Neo-Elizabethan style, with much of the furniture brought from Chatsworth House, the family home in Derbyshire. The garden is 23 acres of formal and woodlands gardens.



Friday 17th April.

Thirsk & Helmsley Market.

£28.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

Travelling to the market town of Thirsk, with chance to explore the attractions of this bustling town, before we take a scenic drive to Helmsley, with the spectacular views from Sutton Bank. Today is market day in Helmsley with its thriving market set in the historic square. Other attractions include the ruined castle and Helmsley Walled Garden. (admissions not included)

Saturday 25th April.

Pendle Village Mill & Lytham St Anne's

£32.45pp. Depart code A.

Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

Pendle Village Mill has a variety of departments including menswear, womenswear, shoes, dining and a garden centre.

Lytham St Anne's is known for its beaches, promenade, pier and tree lined shopping street.



May

Monday 4th May. Scenic North Yorkshire Drive.

£29.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

We visit beautiful Bedale, with its range of shops and cafes along the main street, before we travel to Richmond, passing through Masham and Leyburn and attractive scenery en route. Richmond is famous for its iconic castle as well as its historic buildings and cobbled market.

Saturday 9th May. North Yorks Moors Railway to Whitby.

£59.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We take a ride by steam train on the North York Moors Railway from Pickering enjoying spectacular scenery to Whitby. Once in Whitby you will have the chance to enjoy the attractions of this delightful resort. The return journey, by coach takes in the majestic moorland views. (NB steam engine subject to availability).

Wednesday 13th May. Arnside & Cartmel.

£32.45pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00. Returns for 18.00.

Our day starts at genteel Arnside, a place with a number of independent shops, tasty snack outlets, views over the Kent Estuary towards the Lake District, and pleasant walks over the Knott. We move on to Cartmel, a village with a rich history and an impressive 12th Century Priory, also famously known for its racecourse and sticky toffee pudding shop!

Saturday 16th May. Portmerion.

£63.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.00 - Return for 20.00.

We travel through spectacular Snowdonian scenery to Portmeirion, a magnificent Italianate coastal village created by Sir Clough Williams-Ellis. With its cluster of colour washed houses, set around a central piazza, historic cottages and woodlands.

Wednesday 20th May. Ambleside & Holehird Gardens.

£39.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.00.

Our first call is to popular Ambleside, situated at the northern end of Windermere, with lakeside views and a variety of shops. Later we visit nearby Holehird Gardens (as featured on Gardeners World July 2025) which is a 10 acre fellside garden. Its features include a Rock Garden, Walled Garden and a paddock with trial beds. NB From the coach drop off point there will be a 400yd walk up a steeply sloping tarmac drive.

Saturday 23rd May. Beverley on Market Day

£28.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

We travel to historic Beverley, with its beautiful Minster, on Market Day. There are plenty of stalls in a friendly and vibrant atmosphere, plus the Minster to explore.

Monday 25th May. Scenic Drive - Forest of Bowland to Morecambe.

£32.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

With a call at Settle for a mid-morning break, we take a scenic drive through Slaidburn and the beautiful Forest of Bowland to Morecambe, where amongst its attractions is the restored promenade with glorious views across the bay.

Wednesday 27th May. Yorkshire Lavender & Nunnington Hall.

£47.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 18.00. NT reduction - £10.00

Set in 60 acres overlooking the Vale of York, Yorkshire Lavender has lavender fields, carefully curated gardens, as well as a tea room and a wide selection of plants and gifts. Nunnington Hall is a picturesque manor house with a walled garden and meadows. It is famous for the Carlisle Collection, a set of rooms in miniature.

May/June

Saturday 30th May. Northallerton & Saltburn by the Sea.

£34.95pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.00 - Return 18.30.

We make a morning call at the popular market town of Northallerton, before continuing on to Saltburn by the Sea, which has retained much of its original charm as a Victorian sea side resort with a prom, pier and oldest water balanced cliff tramway in Britain.

Wednesday 3rd June. Llandudno

£43.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 20.00.

A jewel amongst Victorian resorts, Llandudno has a sweeping promenade, a beautiful pier and the Great Orme headland rising abruptly above the town. There are a variety of attractions for to enjoy.

Saturday 6th June. The Lakes & Keswick.

£40.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.30.

We enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Lakes, with a call at Grasmere, on the way to the delightful market town of Keswick situated on the edge of Derwentwater.

Wednesday 10th June. Matlock Bath & Heights of Abraham.

£51.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

Matlock Bath has been called "little Switzerland" on account of its steep wooded hillsides, and magnificent views from the top of them. The towns long high street has quirky shops, as well as a peaceful river side path. Above the town are The Heights of Abraham, a hilltop park of 60 acres which we reach by cable car. Here you can explore the Great Masson Cavern and enjoy the views over the Derwent Valley.

Wednesday 17th June. Sledmere House & Garden with Bridlington.

£54.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

You will have a guided tour of Sledmere House which is steeped in history and is full of unique collections of artwork, furniture and antiques, whilst the Walled Garden is renown for its seasonal displays. Bridlington is a traditional resort with it's stunning beaches and bustling harbour.

Saturday 20th June. Llangollen & Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.

£53.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.30.

In the picturesque town of Llangollen, you can enjoy the attractions which include a preserved railway, horse drawn canal boat trips and Plas Newydd House (admissions not included), plus riverside walks. To finish our day we join a narrow boat for a trip on the Llangollen Canal across the spectacular Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, known as the 'River in the Sky'. Built in 1805 it is the oldest and longest navigable aqueduct in the UK, as well as the highest in the world at over 100 feet.

Wednesday 24th June. "Another Place" & Liverpool

£34.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

'Another Place' is the name for the 100 Antony Gormley statues situated on Crosby Beach – our day starts here when the tide is favourable for a viewing before heading to the Albert Dock area of Liverpool where you have time to peruse its many attractions.

Saturday 27th June. RHS Bridgewater.

£37.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30. RHS Discount -£13.00

The newest of the RHS gardens offers a range of attractions including extensive walled gardens, both flower and vegetable. There are woodland walks for you to enjoy together with the evolving Chinese garden. There is a lovely café by the side of a lake plus a shop and garden centre.
