The picturesque market town has a delightful Christmas Market centred around the historic Market Place, with festive events throughout the town. St John's Church has a Christmas Tree Festival with over 70 beautifully decorated trees. The castle ruins provide spectacular views over the River Nidd and the famous railway viaduct.

Sunday 13th December.

Beverley Festival of Christmas.

Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

Beverley is host to a vibrant Christmas Market with a range of attractions including street entertainment to suit all ages. Within the Minster there is a display of decorated Christmas trees with prizes for the best presented.



Wednesday 16th December. Boundary Mill or Oswaldtwistle Mill.

£24.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

A choice between Boundary Mills with its extensive range of clothing options, homeware and an M&S outlet, OR Oswaldtwistle Mills which has a range of shopping with over 100 retailers under one roof. Both places have dining options as well.

Saturday 19th December. Chester Christmas Market.

£34.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

We travel to the city of Chester to experience the build up to Christmas with lights, trees, decorations and entertainment close to the cathedral, together with a variety of shopping.

Monday 21st December.

Jan/Feb/March

Saturday 9th January. Scenic Drive-North to Wensleydale.

£23.00pp. Depart code A. Depart 10.00 - Return 16.30.

We start the New Year with a leisurely drive through the beautiful winter dales scenery to Hawes, via Ingleton and the Ribbleshead Viaduct, to visit the Wensleydale Creamery with its café, gift and cheese shop.

Saturday 23rd January. North East Hills & Vale of York.

£23.00pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start the day out with a scenic drive over Blubberhouses Moor, Dacre Banks to the popular Thirsk Garden Centre.

Saturday 6th February. Scenic Drive-South to the Peak District .

£23.00pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start our scenic drive via Holmfirth passing through Glossop and the High Peak, with views of Ladybower Reservoir, to the Hope Valley Garden Centre with its range of gardening items, gift ware and household goods as well as a café.

Saturday 20th February. Scenic Drive-West to Lancashire.

£23.00pp. Depart code A. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

Our drive today tracks the course of the River Ribble from Glusburn to Salmesbury before heading north to our destination, Barton Grange Garden Centre, where they have everything to bring your garden and home to life.

Saturday 13th March. Cheshire Choice.

£34.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

A choice today of visiting the historic city of Chester with its magnificent cathedral, Roman Walls and delightful shops **OR** the Cheshire Oaks Designer Outlet shopping with over 100 designer brands **OR** Chester Zoo with its 30,000 animals from over 500 incredible species. **Please note admissions not included.**

Saturday 20th March. Engine Driver's Fish n Chips.

£58.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.15 - Return for 16.30.

We start with a trip over the Pennines to Heywood for a ride on the East Lancashire Railway preserved railway, where we take in views as we travel by steam train from Rawtenstall to Heywood (subject to steam engine availability). We then travel for a late lunch of Fish and Chips at the Olympus Fish Restaurant in Bolton.

Wednesday 24th March. Lakes & Daffodils - Penrith & Ullswater Cruise.

£57.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.00 - Return for 19.30.

We visit Settle for a break, before we continue to Penrith, the delightful market town famous for its independent shops and cafes. We then travel to Pooley Bridge, where we will enjoy a scenic cruise on Ullswater to Glenridding taking in the views of the lake and daffodils.

Saturday 27th March. Scenic Dales Drive.

£32.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

Travelling to Kettlewell for a mid-morning break before journeying via Kidstones Pass to Hawes where you will have time to explore this delightful market town.
We travel back via Garsdale and Kirkby Lonsdale.

April

Friday 2nd April. Thirsk & Helmsley Market.

£28.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 1730.

We travel to the market town of Thirsk, with a chance to explore the attractions of this bustling town, before we take a scenic drive to Helmsley, with spectacular views from Sutton Bank. Today is market day in Helmsley with its thriving market set in the historic square. Other attractions include the ruined castle and Helmsley Walled Gardens. (admissions not included)

Monday 12th April.

Settle to Carlisle Railway.

£68.95pp. Depart code A.

Depart 08.15 - Return for 18.30.

We join our train at Skipton for the iconic journey to Carlisle. The route takes us over the iconic Ribbleshead Viaduct and through Dent Station, the highest station in England. There will be time in Carlisle to explore its attractions before our return journey by coach.



Saturday 17th April. Beamish Open Air Museum.

£55.95pp. Depart code B 08.30 - Return for 18.30.

Beamish highlights life in the Northeast at various times from the 1820's to the 1950's through houses, shops and commercial premises. You can travel round the site on a selection of trams. Here you can try traditional Fish and Chips and a Bakery.

Thursday 22nd April.

Harrogate Spring Flower Show.

£48.25pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

The show is the first major event of the national gardening calendar. This prestigious event features stunning show gardens, live talks and demonstrations and the biggest exhibition by florists and Flower arrangers in the country.



Monday 26th April. Pendle Mill Village & Lytham St Anne's.

£32.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

We start by visiting Pendle Mill Village with 20 unique shops and departments under one roof in a beautifully restored Victorian Mill, which includes a café.

From here we travel to Lytham St Anne's, a relaxed, elegant seaside getaway.

May

Saturday 1st May. Bury Market & Fish n Chip's.

£47.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

From the exotic to the everyday Bury Market has it all. With 370 stalls you are sure to find what you're looking for at bargain prices. From here we travel to the award winning Olympus Fish and Chip restaurant in Bolton for a traditional meal of cod, chips, peas, bread and butter with tea or coffee, and dessert.

Monday 3rd May. Scenic Drive - Forest of Bowland to Morecambe.

£32.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

With a call at Clitheroe for a mid-morning break, we take a scenic drive through the beautiful Forest of Bowland to Morecambe, where amongst its attractions is the restored promenade with glorious views across the bay.

Saturday 15th May.

North Yorks Railway to Whitby.

£60.95pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.00 - Returns for 19.00.

We take a ride by steam train on the North Yorks Moors Railway from Pickering enjoying beautiful scenery to Whitby. Once in Whitby you can explore the numerous attractions of this delightful resort including its famous fish and chip shops.

The return journey, by coach, takes in the majestic moorland views. (NB steam engine subject to availability).



Wednesday 19th May. Kirby Lonsdale, Cartmel & Grange over Sands.

£37.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

Our day starts at Kirby Lonsdale, a place with a number of independent shops, riverside walks and the famous Ruskin's view. We move on to Cartmel, a village with a rich history and an impressive 12th century Priory, also famously known for its racecourse and sticky toffee pudding shop. Our final call is the elegant Edwardian seaside resort of Grange Over Sands.

Saturday 22nd May. Northallerton & Saltburn by the Sea.

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

We make a morning call at the popular market town of Northallerton, before continuing on to Saltburn by the Sea, which has retained much of its original charm as a Victorian seaside resort with a promenade, pier and oldest water balanced cliff tramway in Britain.

Saturday 29th May. Beverley on Market Day.

£29.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

We travel to historic Beverley, with its beautiful Minster, on Market Day. There are plenty of stalls in a friendly and vibrant atmosphere, plus the Minster to explore.

Monday 31st May. Scenic Dales Drive.

£30.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

We visit the beautiful market town of Bedale, famously known as the 'Gateway to the Dales' for a mid-morning break. We then travel to Richmond to give you time to explore the attractions of this historic town which include the ruins of the castle.

June

Thursday 3rd June. Breezy Knees Gardens.

£41.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

Spread over 20 acres of award winning gardens and described by Monty Don as 'a beautiful modern garden created on the grandest possible scale' the gardens are a delight. At this time of year much of the gardens will be at their seasonal best, with a lake and gentle walks to enjoy.

Saturday 5th June. Seahouses & Farne Islands Cruise.

£71.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 20.30.

We travel to the coastal village of Seahouses, where you will have a chance to explore. In addition, you will have a 90 minute grey seal cruise, which takes you around all the Farne Islands, providing the opportunity to view the resident seabirds.

Wednesday 9th June.

Llandudno.

£43.95pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.00 - Returns for 20.00.

A jewel amongst Victorian resorts, Llandudno has a sweeping promenade, a beautiful pier, and the Great Orme headland. There is a wide variety of attractions, shops and cafes to explore.



Saturday 12th June. RHS Bridgewater.

£40.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30. RHS Discount £15.00

The newest of the RHS gardens offers a range of attractions including extensive walled gardens, both flower and vegetable. There are woodland walks for you to enjoy as well as the evolving Chinese garden. There is a lakeside café, shop and garden centre to peruse.

Saturday 19th June. Pennine Spectacular to Durham.

£42.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.30.

We travel with a stop en route to Penrith, a delightful market town with independent shopping to Stanhope, with a stop at the Dales Centre. We then continue to the cathedral city of Durham.

Wednesday 23rd June. Grasmere & Keswick.

£40.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.30.

Following a brief call at Settle, we travel with time to visit picturesque Grasmere, before continuing on to popular Keswick, where Derwentwater is a short stroll away, as is Hope Park with its stunning gardens and views.

Saturday 26th June. Arley Hall Garden Festival.

£51.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 17.30.

We visit stunning Arley Hall, set in 15 acres of gardens, famous for its annual garden festival with its floral marquee, plant nursery, display gardens and double herbaceous border. Garden tours are available during the day, as are a programme of talks and demonstrations.

Wednesday 30th June. Liverpool and/or "Another Place"

£35.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 18.30.

We travel to Liverpool where you can spend the day exploring the Albert Dock complex and the Liverpool shopping area, OR, there is an option to visit the Antony Gormley statues at Crosby before returning later to Liverpool to visit the attractions.

July

Saturday 3rd July. Bakewell Well Dressing & Carnival Day.

£35.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 19.00.

The ancient custom is unique to Derbyshire and is the art of decorating wells and springs with pictures made from natural materials. There are 5 wells in Bakewell and today is carnival day, where you can soak up the atmosphere and watch a procession with floats, bands and a carnival queen.

Thursday 8th July. Yorkshire Lavender & Burton Agnes Hall.

£60.95pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.00 - Return 19.00.

Set in 60 acres overlooking the Vale of York, Yorkshire Lavender has lavender fields, carefully curated gardens, as well as a tea room and a wide selection of gifts and plants. Burton Agnes Hall is an Elizabethan manor house, with a walled garden, as well as a market garden area.

Sunday 11th July. Sunday Lunch on the River Tees.

£62.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.15 - Return for 17.30.

We travel to Stockton-on-Tees to join our lunch time cruise for a three hour sail amongst the scenery and wildlife of the River Tees, whilst enjoying your two course roast beef or roast chicken Sunday lunch followed by a dessert. (choice required on booking).

Wednesday 14th July. Great Yorkshire Show.

£57.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.15 - Return for 17.00.

Enjoy a day at the celebration of agriculture, food, farming and countryside as well as the best in British livestock, forestry, hives and honey. There is a fabulous food hall, cookery demonstrations, garden shows and country pursuits.

Saturday 17th July. Llangollen & Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.

£51.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.30.

In the picturesque town of Llangollen, situated on the banks of the River Dee you can enjoy the attractions which include the heritage steam railway, Plas Newydd House and a riverside walk (admissions to attractions not included). To finish our day we join a narrowboat for a trip on the Llangollen Canal across the spectacular Pontcysyllte Aqueduct. The aqueduct built in 1805 is the oldest and longest in the UK as well as the highest in the world at over 100 feet.

Friday 23rd July.

RHS Tatton Flower Show.

£TBCpp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.00 - Return for 17.30.

Encounter fabulous show gardens, highlighting the best in horticultural design. Shop with some of the UK's finest growers and be inspired by live chat and demonstrations of gardening and culinary matters.



Tuesday 27th July. Whitby.

£37.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We visit the ever popular resort of Whitby, with its range of attractions situated under the ruins of the magnificent Abbey. These include walks along the vibrant quayside, golden sands and the famous 199 steps leading up to the Abbey and St Marys Church.
